

Lake Bloomington Rules & Regulations (not exclusive)

NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES Possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited both on the Lake and Lake Bloomington public property. (City Code 6-26d/23-44/31-701, \$250 citation)


NO SWIMMING Lake Residents and their Guests may swim within 100' of leased lot; however, outside this area, swimming is prohibited. (City Code 23-12, \$100 citation)

NO LITTERING (City Code 23-8, \$100 citation), **NO PUBLIC URINATION** (City Code 28-33, \$100 citation), **NO FIGHTING** (City Code 28-6, \$100 citation)

NO OPEN FIRES Fires permitted in grills only. (City Code 23-22, \$100 citation)

NO CAMPING (City Code 23-16)

NO VEHICLES/BIKES OFF ROADWAYS (City Code 23-37)



TUBING & WATER SKIING: Allowed between 12-7pm only. Participants must wear life saving device. Boats must have **TWO** operators (driver & observer) but may pull only **ONE** participant at a time. **Must show 12"x12" orange safety flag at highest point on boat.** Start from water, not shore or dock. Do not tube/ski within 100' of shore or docks. Turns to be **counterclockwise**. (City Code 23-13, \$100 citation) **NO JET SKIS or WAVE RUNNERS.**

Boating

City Code 23-14, \$100 citation *per incident*

Must have current-year STATE & CITY LICENSES/PERMITS.

STATE REQUIRED EQUIPMENT ABOARD (life preservers, fire extinguisher, night lighting, etc). Display proper LIGHTING when dark. Passengers under age 13 must wear approved PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICE.



MAX 40HP motor.

MAX 25MPH (except in NO WAKE zones). OBSERVE NO WAKE ZONES (max 5mph), entire lake is NO WAKE from sunset to 7am.

Motor boats must YIELD to non-motorized watercrafts.

NO LOADS OVER CAPACITY. NO STANDING while boat is underway. NO RACING. NO CARELESS or RECKLESS OPERATION. NO ALCOHOL.



Fishing

Must have current STATE LICENSE.

No fishing within 100' OF LEASED PROPERTIES or DAM.

Hook & line fishing only (NO JUGS or TROT LINES).

Observe current SIZE & CREEL LIMITS (effective 4/1/2017):

Fish Species	Min. Length	Daily Limit
Small/Largemouth Bass	15"	3
Walleye	18"	3
Northern Pike	24"	3
Crappie	none	15
Striped, White, Hybrid Bass	17"	3
Bluegill	none	none
Catfish	none	none
