

Kickapoo Creek Watershed Geoheritage Trail

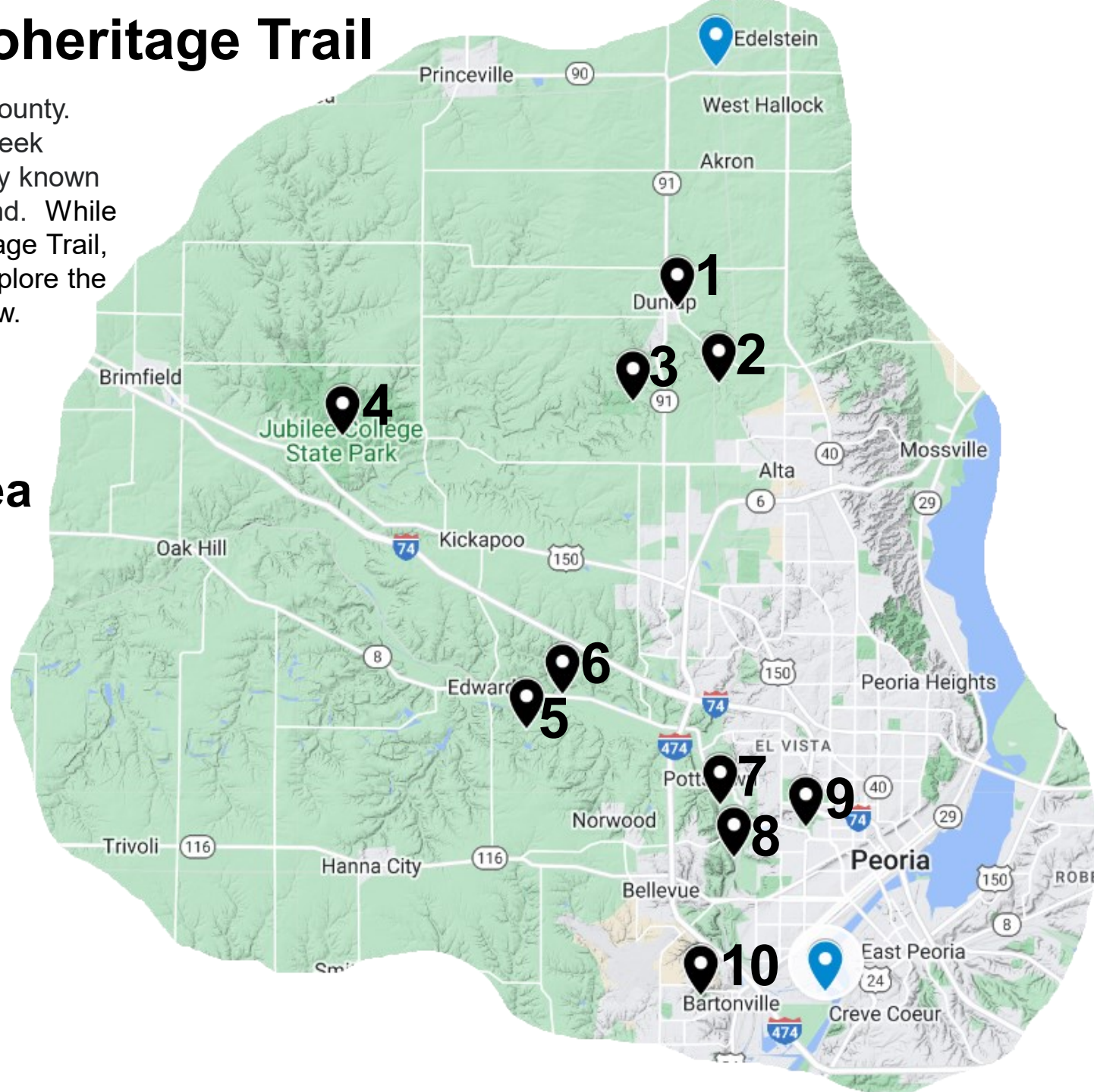
The entirety of the Kickapoo Creek Watershed is in Peoria county.

Indeed, about 80% of Peoria County is in the Kickapoo Creek Watershed. Its geology is fascinating and yet little is commonly known about this creek that has shaped life in Peoria county and beyond. While there is not yet an official Kickapoo Creek Watershed Geoheritage Trail, there are several public access areas where it is possible to explore the geology of this Central Illinois gem.
